The Research Assistant will support convenings of US-based scientists reviewing the core consumer safe food handling messages of Fight BAC!®.

The review will be executed as a combination of virtual whiteboard sessions and a final report input session in late January, 2021.

The convening will result in a report and set of recommendations to the non-profit Partnership for Food Safety Education and its Federal liaisons.

The role of research assistant includes:

- Prepare a consumer food safety research compilation and other research documents
- Assist in administrative and content aspects of the virtual convenings
- Track participation, send reminders, and collate expert input
- Prepare and circulate summary notes and task lists from meetings
- Maintain project calendar
- Maintain project files
- Develop a final visual presentation

The Research Assistant will have the opportunity to meet leading experts, and to develop and strengthen research and analytics skills. This temporary contract position provides a chance to gain firsthand non-profit experience.
