YOUR CONTRIBUTION

Planning

Develop a business plan for the active engagement of food tech businesses in the non-profit Partnership for Food Safety Education. Participate in strategy discussions and planning with the organization's Executive Director and Development Director.

Research and Writing

Compile research. Write case statements and LinkedIn posts aimed at the food industry and food tech businesses making the case for financial investment in PFSE and its products.

Capacity Building

Strategize with PFSE senior staff on building capacity over the coming 3 years consistent with the organization's core strategies:

- 1) To lead in developing and disseminating timely and effective messages on reducing risk of foodborne illness;
- 2) To activate influencers to deliver preventive health messages to US consumers; and
- 3) To secure the resources required to act effectively to achieve its strategic goals.

REQUIREMENTS

Ideal applicants are current graduate students or recent graduates. Strong analytical and writing skills are a must. A MINIMUM TOTAL COMMITMENT OF 150 HOURS IS REQUIRED. A bi-weekly stipend of \$500 is provided. The intern reports to the Executive Director.
